Pralognan-la-Vanoise is a small, traditional French village, which has been a mountain destination for over 150 years. The resort is full of charm and its small ski area packs a punch for those who like off-piste skiing or ski touring, whilst also catering for families with slopes for all (there are 9 green runs).

The village is set amongst breathtaking natural scenery and its architectural heritage adds to its character. It also punches above its weight for facilities, as one of the venues hosting the 1992 Winter Olympics, it boasts a sports centre with Olympic ice rink, climbing wall, swimming pool and bowling alley, as well as a good range of family-friendly activities such as dog-sledding, igloo building and rides on a pony-drawn sleigh.

DRIVING TO THE FRENCH ALPS

Kick off your ski holiday with a mini road trip! Load up the car with your gear, your home comforts and maybe even the family dog. Driving to the French Alps gives you the freedom to travel your way, whether you complete the journey in one day or take it at a more leisurely pace with scenic stops. Here are our top tips for driving to the Alps.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE (INCLUDING STOPS)

Map out your journey in advance, including rest and meal breaks. This avoids any tension about where to stop when everyone is getting hungry.

KNOW YOUR SPEED LIMITS

France uses kilometres per hour so it helps to know the key conversions from miles per hour. Speed limits are reduced depending on driving conditions, for example the

motorway speed limit reduces from 130km/h to 110km/h in rain or snow.

CONSIDER A TOLL TAG

French toll booths are on the left-hand side which can be tricky if your passenger is asleep. Toll tags like Emovis let you drive straight through and you receive a single invoice after your trip.

CARRY SNOW CHAINS

If travelling between 1st November and 31st March,

by law you will need to carry snow chains, snow socks or have winter tyres fitted. Even outside of those dates, it's advisable as mountain weather can be unpredictable. Our partner at snowchains.com can help with these.

HAVE YOU CONSIDERED THE TRAIN?

Sit back, relax and be whisked down to the mountains

Travelling to the French Alps by train can be a less stressful and scenic alternative to flying. There are two main routes to choose from, one via Lille (Eurostar Snow train) and one via Paris. Both have their advantages. With Lille, you simply change platforms and continue your journey. With Paris, you could break up your trip with a night in the city before heading to the slopes.

Once on board, settle down to enjoy stunning views of the French countryside. Train tickets often compare well with the cost of flights but you avoid the hassle of airports and enjoy shorter transfer times to resort.

OUR TRAIN TIPS

ORGANISE TAXI TRANSFERS IN ADVANCE

Pre-book your taxi transfers from your arrival station with us to save waiting for an available taxi. We can also

organise transfers between stations in Paris if you want to avoid the Métro.

PRE-PLAN ENTERTAINMENT

Bring plenty to do to break up the journey, especially if travelling with children. Think travel board games, puzzle books and films on a tablet. Good neck pillows are well worth investing in so everyone can nap comfortably.

OFF THE BEATEN TRACK

Looking for something a little different this ski season? Tucked away among the big-name resorts are smaller, lesser-known gems that might be just what you're after.

These alpine villages offer a charming alternative to the more purpose-built resort centres, with traditional wood and stone buildings and an authentic mountain atmosphere.

If you're not big on queuing and prefer peaceful slopes, these quieter resorts are ideal, even on peak weeks. Here are three of our favourite hidden gems.

LE GRAND BORNAND

Just an hour from Geneva and among the resorts with the shortest drive from Calais, Le Grand Bornand is one of the most accessible resorts in the French Alps. It's great for beginners and families or those easing themselves back into skiing. Cheese-lovers take note: the resort is the birthplace of the delicious Reblochon cheese.

RECOMMENDED STAY

Le Roc de Tours

These luxurious apartments are just a stone's throw from one of the main ski lifts, offering a comfortable and relaxing base for your holiday. Indoor pool and spa facilities.

LES CONTAMINES

A true gem hidden in the large Evasion Mont Blanc ski area, boasting 445km of skiing (not all lift linked). This former farming village (a favourite of one of our local colleagues) has retained its traditional charm, with a beautifully restored Baroque church and attractive timber chalets.

Laska

With beautiful views over Mont Joly and the ski slopes, Laska offers 49 modern apartments, just a short walk from the resort centre. Indoor pool and spa facilities.

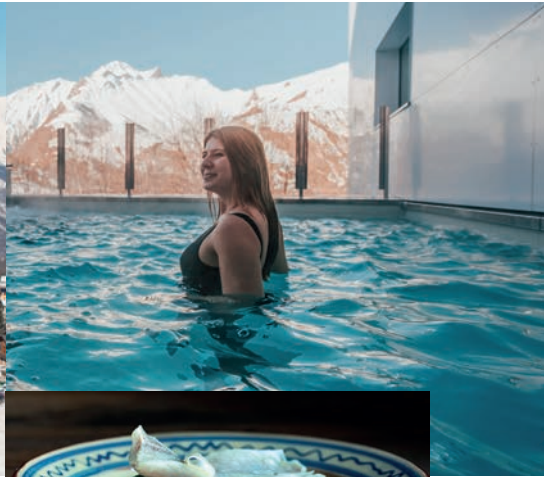

We help a lot of skiers plan their ski holidays and we are seeing more families travelling as a group, booking a few apartments and making the most of the mountains together. Having done this ourselves too, we wanted to share the reasons why this works, and some tips if you're thinking 'the more the merrier' when it comes to your next trip.

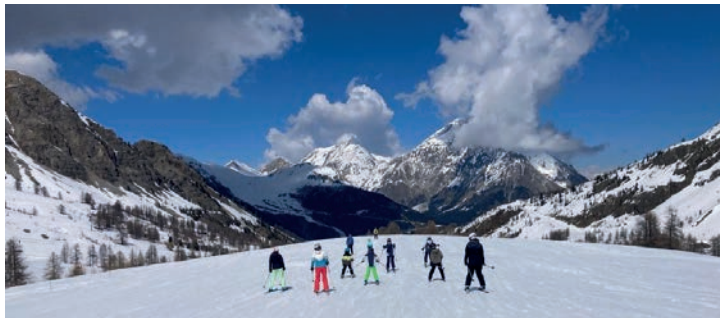
WHY WE LOVE MULTI-FAMILY TRIPS

There's always someone to ski with – whether your children prefer to challenge themselves and you just want to take it easy, or you're the one looking for an adrenaline rush and they want to spend hours doing the same green run, the beauty of a multi-family trip is that invariably someone else will want to do the same thing. Hook up with different friends every day and everyone's happy.

Games nights – our children love a games night with friends. Plan it for the last night and you can get on with packing while they play! Lots of our properties have communal lounges that are ideal for this.



Shared experiences – have a go at activities together that you might not otherwise have



tried; book a fondue in a yurt, go to an ice hockey match, try snow-yoga - experiences like these make memories and cement friendships.

Ski school with friends – with a larger group there's a chance your children will know someone in their ski school class, this can help their confidence, which in turn means they are likely to learn more.

TOP TIPS

Ensure each family has their own apartment so everyone has space to relax.

Plan one meal out as a group - don't put pressure on yourselves to be together all the time but having one evening out is a lovely way to catch up with everyone mid-stay.

Meet up in the same place at the end of each morning (a café terrace works well) - then everyone knows where to find each other if ski school runs late, you can share stories of your day so far and see who wants to ski where in the afternoon.

Start with a planning session; consider what you all want from a resort (off-slope activities, a traditional feel, lively après etc.) and from your accommodation (is a pool a must-have? a gym?). Think about any boarders and non-skiers in your group and what runs you'll need for different abilities. Then, speak to the Peak Retreats team, who can guide you through your options based on what matters to your group.

The world-famous Tignes Val d'Isère ski area offers an impressive 300km of slopes and some of Europe's best high-altitude skiing.

Tignes Le Lac sits at the heart of the Tignes villages and is a great all-round base, with easy access to the slopes, a lively atmosphere and a good mix of shops, bars and restaurants. Tignes 1800 is a smaller, quieter, but well-designed, good value base from which you can ski this amazing area. It has a large beginners' area and quick and easy access into the wider ski area.

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SAINTE FOY

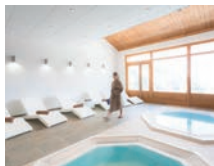
