For complete beginners, please note that there is also a slightly cheaper lift pass covering Montgenève ski area only (65km) although we cannot pre-book this so it has to be bought in resort (approx €40/adult/day, €28/child). The full 'Via Lattea/Milky Way' lift pass covering 400km of pistes is also to be arranged locally.

**PASS DIRETTO:** pre-book your Frejus Tunnel pass for £41 return (instead of €56.30 return or €46.50 each way when bought at the toll) - valid for a car (max 2m high) with a minimum of 4 passengers (to be advised and booked at least 4 weeks prior to departure)

### Important notes:

**Ski School:** Please note that lesson times are subject to change right until the last minute. Outside French school holidays the ski school reserves the right to cancel group lessons should numbers be insufficient. For peak periods (24/12-7/1, 11/2-11/3 & 31/3-24/4) we strongly recommend that you book as early as possible and in any case at least 6 weeks prior to the required dates. Morning lessons tend to get booked up first and therefore we may only be able to offer afternoon classes within 6 weeks of departure. In some resorts English speaking instructors may not always be available, particularly at peak times.

### PLEASE NOTE

Our extras ££ prices are calculated at the exchange rate that applies when the calculations are done.
